POP SPLATTER PITCHER



MATERIALS

- Contempo Pitcher DB22696
 - #6 Fan Brush
 - #6 Round Brush
 - Foil for palette
 - Potter's sponge
 - Pencil
 - Paper towels
 - 4 Small plastic bottles with squeeze tips (approx. 2-oz. size)
 - Container for water
 - Paper cup
 - Clear glaze
- CMM Colors:
- 21 Mango Madness
 - 90 Red Hot
 - 47 Deep Sea
 - 31 Licorice

TIP

- When watering the glaze to a milky consistency, use an appropriate ratio of one part glaze to one part water. If you add too much glaze, the color will not move enough for a watercolor effect. If you add too much water, the color will be very light.

Color Me Mine

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Before you begin, wipe a damp sponge over entire bisque to remove dust and contaminants.
2. Pour some clear glaze into a paper cup and add a small amount of water until glaze is a creamy consistency. Pour into pitcher and roll around to coat the entire inside. Pour remaining glaze back into cup and set aside.
3. Shake bottles of glaze before use. Pour each of the four colors of glaze into their own individual plastic bottle with tip, filling about halfway. Squeeze out on paper towel to test. Set aside.
4. Lightly sketch random, irregular circles on pitcher with pencil. Refer to photo.
5. Pour puddles of Mango Madness, Red Hot, Deep Sea and Licorice onto a piece of foil. Load the #6 round brush with one color at a time and fill in circles. Apply color liberally as you will need only one coat.
6. One at a time, take plastic bottles filled with color and squeeze several lines of color extending randomly from the corresponding colored circles. Refer to photo. Let dry.
7. Use #6 Fan Glaze to apply one coat of the thinned clear glaze in paper cup (create more if needed) over pitcher, being careful not to brush over colors excessively to avoid smearing. Let dry.
8. Apply a second undiluted coat, carefully brushing over the colored areas.
9. Stilt and fire to cone 06.
